Week 1 John 1:1-18

1. Who is the Word, through whom all things were created in the beginning?
2. How is John compared to Jesus? What was John's purpose? (Note: This is not the same "John" who wrote the book of John.)
3. How are light and darkness used to contrast Jesus and the world?

Week 2 Luke 1:67-80

1. List at least 3 things that Zechariah said about Jesus in this passage.
2. Regarding verse 77, list some sins for which you need forgiveness.
3. What did John do as a child, before he started to appear in public to preach about Jesus?

Week 3 Luke 2:1-20

1. Why did Joseph and Mary go to Bethlehem?
2. In verses 10-11, what did the angel tell the shepherds?
3. What did the shepherds say and do after the angels went away?

Week 4 Matthew 2:1-23

1. What did the wise men say to King Herod? What did he tell them in response?
2. Why did the angel tell Joseph to take his family to Egypt? Compare this event to Israel's exodus from Egypt after the 10 plagues.
3. What tragedy took place due to King Herod's jealousy (from hearing that another king had been born)?

Week 5 Luke 3:1-20

1. What warning did John the Baptist give concerning those who claim to follow God but whose lifestyles don't show it?
2. What advice did John give to the crowd, and specifically to those who were tax collectors and soldiers?
3. In verses 16-17, how does John describe Jesus?

Week 6 Matthew 3:13 – 4:11

1. How did John the Baptist respond when he was asked to baptize Jesus?
2. In what ways did Satan tempt Jesus in the desert?
3. What did Jesus use to rebuke each temptation from Satan?

Week 7 John 3:1-21

1. How does Jesus compare the wind to the workings of the Holy Spirit?
2. What promise does Jesus make in verse 16, and what warning does He give in verse 18?
3. In verses 19-21, what does Jesus say about people in the world who have not been born again in Jesus?
